Stereos ( and headphones) may be brought to camp. Televisions, game boys, pagers, and computers are NOT allowed. Please leave these items at home.

MARK ALL ARTICLES BROUGHT TO CAMP WITH THE NAME OF THE CAMPER!!! “Sharpie” permanent markers are the most efficient and easiest method of marking items. A list of all items should be taped to the inside of the trunk.
